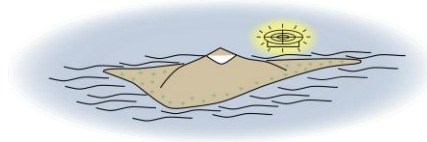

IPS – Heidelberg – Award 2010

Scope

- Support of young scientists in innovative research on the interrelation of structure and function in glaucoma

Statute

The „IPS – Heidelberg – Award“ will be presented during the IPS Tenerife Symposium.

The award is a personal one and not for support of a team. The donor may divide the award equally or in different categories (“gold”, “silver”, “bronze”) according to the ranking of the selection procedure.

The prize is or the prizes are distributed at the IPS banquet by the President of the IPS or his nominee together with a representative of the donor.

The award for the following IPS Symposium will be announced at the dinner and repeated with each call for papers. The necessary disclosure of the age of an applicant should always be made known.

The requirements for an application for this award are:

- First- or second author in a publication which is submitted for a Symposium of the IPS.
- Responsibility for the scientific content of the publication.
- Innovative work judged of outstanding quality in the area of the relationship between morphology and function as required by the IPS (e.g. Ophthalmology, Medical Optics, blood circulation of the eye)
- Membership in good standing in the IPS (International Perimetric Society)
- Maximum age 40 years or less in the year of the IPS Symposium.

Selection process

The selection committee for the prize will consist of the President, the Secretary and the 2 IPS board members responsible for imaging and membership.

The application forms & abstracts are submitted to the IPS Secretariat prior to the next IPS meeting. Those which are within the scope of the IPS – Heidelberg - Award distributed to the members of the selection committee as preliminary information.

The members of the selection committee will agree on the modalities prior to the beginning of the next IPS meeting. The election will take place immediately after the scientific part of the symposium.

The anonymous voting shall allow a weighting of the relevant oral papers and posters according to the quality, innovative content and personal input of the applicant.

Each member of the selection committee may request to have a substitute. The voting has to take place between the end of the last scientific session and the IPS closing banquet. The secretary of the IPS will count or delegate the counting of the votes. The results are made known forthwith to the members of the selection committee and the sponsor.

The sponsor may decide to divide the award to more than one winner according to the results of the voting. The sponsor prepares the handing out of the prize or prizes.

The results of the award are final and no appeal is permitted.
